A B O U T T H E D E S I G N E R :

Knud Friis (1926-2010) and Elmar Moltke Nielsen (1924-1997) founded FRIIS & MOLTKE in 1954. In the 1960s they introduced Danes to their mild version of Brutalism, which often featured huge, robust building structures tucked into the landscape, raw concrete walls and visible technical installations.

Knud Friis and Elmar Moltke Nielsen had a unique creative partnership and their groundbreaking projects both in Denmark and abroad made a decisive impact on Danish architecture. The two partners worked together on virtually all the buildings, in which their joint practice was involved.
